



The Ross County Sheriff's Office is a collective bargaining organization operating under the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Local #284 [union].



WHAT DOES THAT MEAN?

The Ross County Sheriff's Office is in operation twenty-four hours a day, three hundred and sixty-five days a year. Because we are a collective bargaining unit, details such as positions available, shifts available, and days off available are filled by seniority, in accordance with the contract.

Through 06/30/2019, wages are based on the following scale:

	0-1 years	1-3 years
Certified Peace Officer	\$16.70	\$17.43
Corrections Officer	\$16.56	\$17.29
Communications	\$14.51	\$15.21
Civil	\$14.26	\$14.85

Wages are scheduled for increase at a rate of 2.5% again on 07/01/2019.

A total of \$150 is withheld as an initiation fee into the union. This will come in the form of two \$75 deductions in separate checks.

The contract in operation at this time is set to expire 06/30/2020.
